CONSERVATION

- Dedicated **5,380** hours of assessment, planning and implementation of conservation programming to support the development of TUC's management plans for Canada's water.
- Rescued and repatriated **23,860** fish across Canada to protect threatened fish and bring awareness to the importance of native fish species.
- Continued to fight climate change while improving air and water quality through the planting of over **4,680** trees.
- Repaired and connected over **17** kms of river and stream habitat. Protecting and enhancing native fish populations improving water quality while reducing the increasing impact of climate change.

EDUCATION

- Through our national education programs, focusing on non-point source pollution, water quality and stream restoration, we educated over **10,575** people, improving knowledge and awareness.
- Engaged **99** partners and education leaders enabling and empowering over **81** local communities across Canada.
- Engaged and empowered over **20,945** people through **247** presentations.

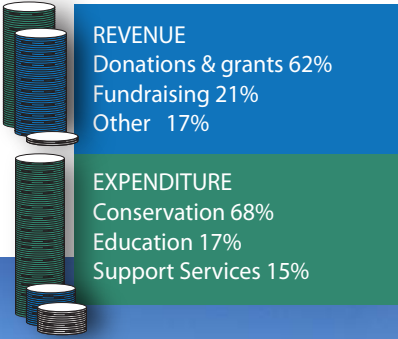
